BROCHURE FOR CSWIP 3.1 WELDING INSPECTOR COURSE

Suitable for professionals in welding industry willing to upgrade skill sets to International Industry Standards and get the globally accepted certification. Persons who have minimum of 3 years experience in the field of welding inspection or 5 years as welding Supervisor are eligible to attend CSWIP 3.1 Welding Inspector course and exam as per the details are given in document CSWIP WI-6-92 edition.

Registrations for the courses are done on first come first served basis. We need to send the list to TWI atleast 2 weeks in advance. Hence you are requested to plan for early registration accordingly.

The formats of Enrolment form, CV form, vision certificate and CSWIP documentation are available as download files in Home Page. The course is of 4 days tutorial followed by 1 day of examinations. You may register for any course schedule of 2011 in advance.

Procedure for Registration

You are requested to send scan copies of CV and enrolment form (see [download files](#) in home page) duly filled, signed and attested by your present employer. If employment in present company is less than 3 years, previous experience certificates covering total of 3 years in welding inspection or 5 years as Welding Foremen / Supervisor / Inspector etc., We shall review the soft copies and send approval mail.

The following documents should be couriered after receiving CV approval e-mail from us.

1. The Original Enrolment forms and CV
2. Payment in the form of DD or wire transfer details (see download file "[mode of payment](#)")
3. Copy of Experience / Service certificates to be provided only if present attested service is less than 3 years.
4. Vision certificate format ([download file](#))
5. 2 nos PP size photographs (write full name and sign on backside of both the photos).

Copies of educational certificates and NDT not required.

On receipt of the above courier we shall confirm your seat and forward the latest TWI course material to your address in India and also provide list of nearby budget hotels with tariff & contact details for you use if required.

Examination Pattern

Theory Part A2: General Welding Theory, Product Technology and NDT 30 multiple choice questions -- 45 minutes.

Theory Part B2: Specific Welding Technology. 60 multiple choice questions. Time allowed 1hr 30 minutes.

Practical Part A2: Inspection of a plate butt weld to a code provided by the Test Centre. Time allowed 1hr 15 minutes

Practical Part B2: Inspection of a pipe butt weld to a code provided by the Test Centre. Time allowed 1hr 45 minutes

Practical Part C2: Inspection of a set of 2 Nos. macro test samples to a code provided by the Test Centre. 45 minutes

We will provide a orientation program on day before start of course at same venue for free of cost for briefing on the course and exam details.

Fees

The course and examination fee is 1000 GBP (Great Britain Pounds) which must be converted and paid in Indian Rupees as per details in **Mode of Payment** (see download file in home page).

Tea, snacks & lunch are provided during the class. This is a non-residential programme and individuals have to make their own arrangement for stay. We will forward a list of nearby hotels with tariff and contact details.

You are also requested to inform your friends and colleagues who are interested in these certification courses. You may please feel free to contact us for any further details.

Retests are also conducted at the end of each CSWIP 3.1 Welding Inspector courses along with initial candidates. These are conducted at the end of all CSWIP 3.1 and 3.2 exams for those candidates who could not qualify in the Initial exam. The fee for retest is 190 GBP.
