7. Copy of CSWIP 3.1 Certificate

CSWIP 3.2 Welding Inspector Exam pattern is as follows :

Part I - Specific Theory – 1 Hour 15 Mints
1 Question on Signing off a product or Duties of a Senior Welding Inspector

Part II - Weld Symbols (12 symbols) – 1 Hour

Part III - Fracture Analysis (2 specimens) – 1 Hour

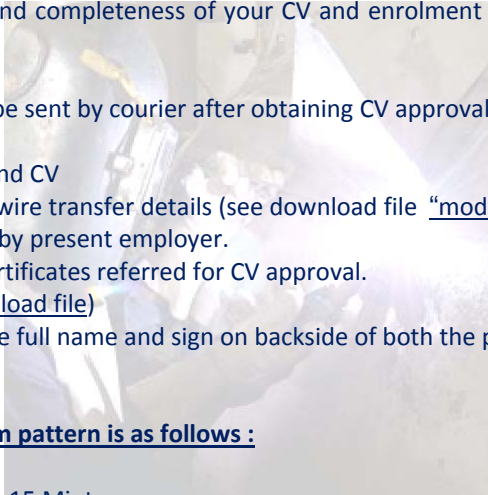
Part IV - NDT Report Scrutiny (3 reports) – 1 Hour

Part V - Oral – 15 Mints

Part VI - Radiographic Film Interpretation (6 films) – 1Hour

Part VII – Multi choice questions – Radiography (20 questions) – 30 Mints

Part VIII - Sensitivity calculations (5 questions) Densito meter Calibration (5 Readings)
